Code of conduct for members

Every member of Macarthur Beekeepers Association Inc (Association) is expected to comply with a code of conduct for members as published by the executive. A member should comply with the following standards of conduct:

- 1.The member should act honestly, in good faith and in the best interests of the Association (club) and its goals
- 2.The member volunteering in a role within the Association has a duty to use care and diligence in the interest of the association and fellow members assigning respect to the executive and fellow office bearers Note see also *Description of Roles*
- 3.The member should respect fellow member opinions and decisions made by or thru the committee.
- 4.The member should recognise that the primary responsibility of the association is for the a whole of the association based on its constitution and complimentary Good Governance Guide (GGG).
- 5.The member should not make improper use of information acquired via the association
- 6.The member should not take improper advantage others
- 7.The member should demonstrate that any conflict is resolved in the interests of the association and fellow members
- 8.The member has an obligation to be independent in judgment and actions and to take all reasonable steps to be satisfied as to the soundness of all decisions taken by the committee.
- 9.Confidential information received by the any means via the association or related activities are to remain the property of Macarthur Beekeepers Association Inc from which it was obtained and it is improper to disclose it, or allow it to be disclosed, unless that disclosure has been authorised by the executive, or the person from whom the information is provided, or is required by law.
- 10.The member should not engage in conduct likely to bring discredit upon the association , any office bearers or fellow members
- 11.The member has an obligation, at all times, to comply with the spirit, as well as the letter, of the law and with the principles of this Code
12. By signing the application for membership or renewal form a members agrees to personally take appropriate steps to gain excess and understanding of the constitution and the content of GGG
